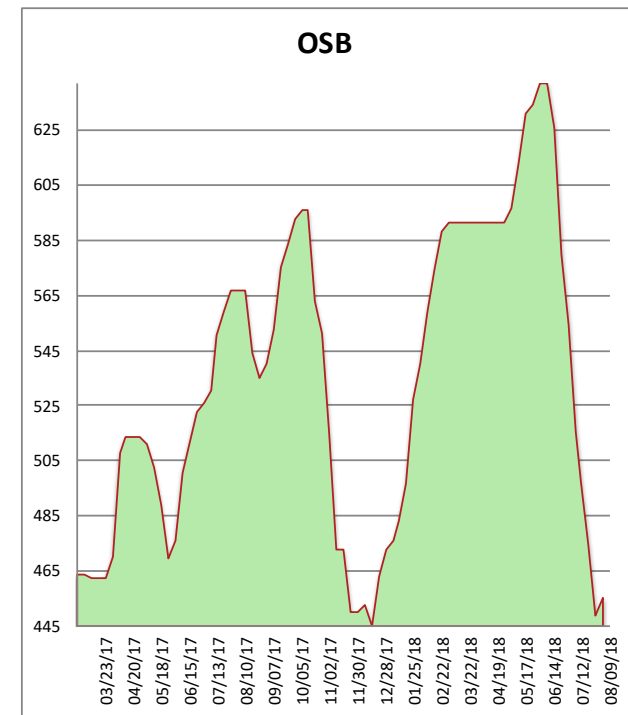
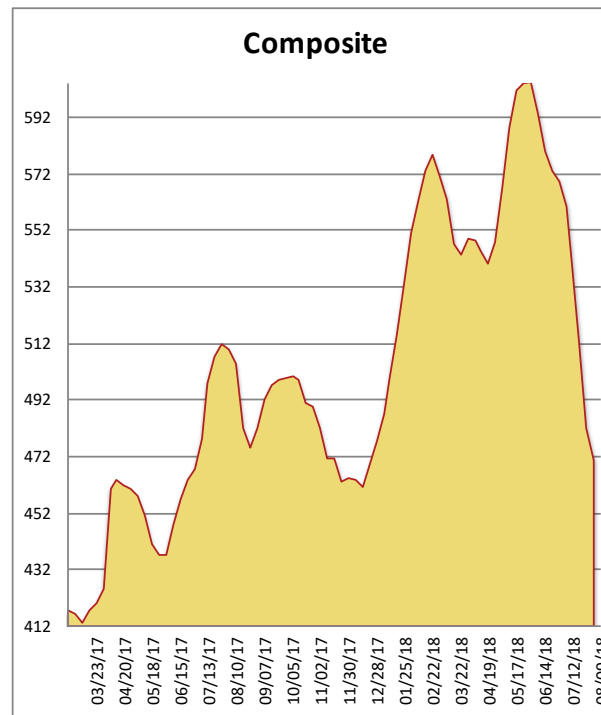

Framing lumber continued on a downward trend as mills aggressively offered discounts and searched for trading levels. Prices of 2x6 dimension continue to see the deepest price cuts. OSB sales activity surged across all regions as many buyers stepped in to cover immediate needs with a sense of urgency. Most mill prices were firm to slightly higher and some reported order files moving into early September. In Western Canada, more rail car shortages are a growing concern as many mills look to raise quotes. SE OSB mills raised prices again Thursday mid morning as order files continued to grow.
