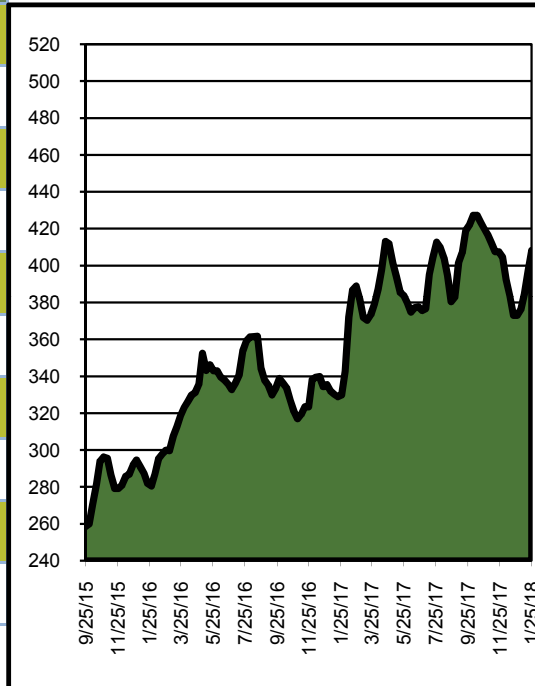

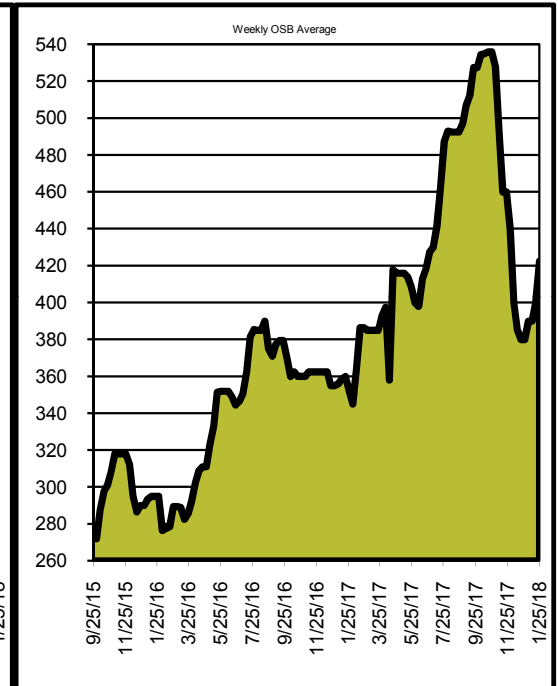

An OSB mill press crack in the south pulled some supply out of play for the better part of a month. Prices on OSB climbed, as did both Western and Southern plywood. Stud trims – especially DF longs – were very difficult to source. Distributors in many markets have been pre-selling material off of inbound cars and trucks.
