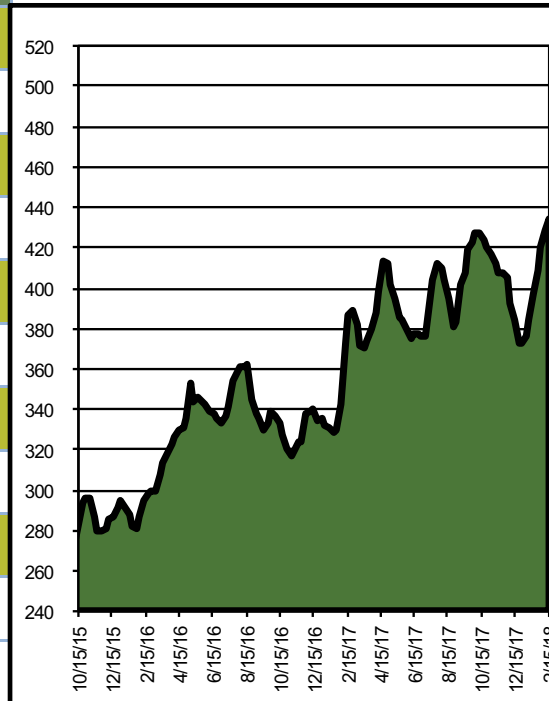

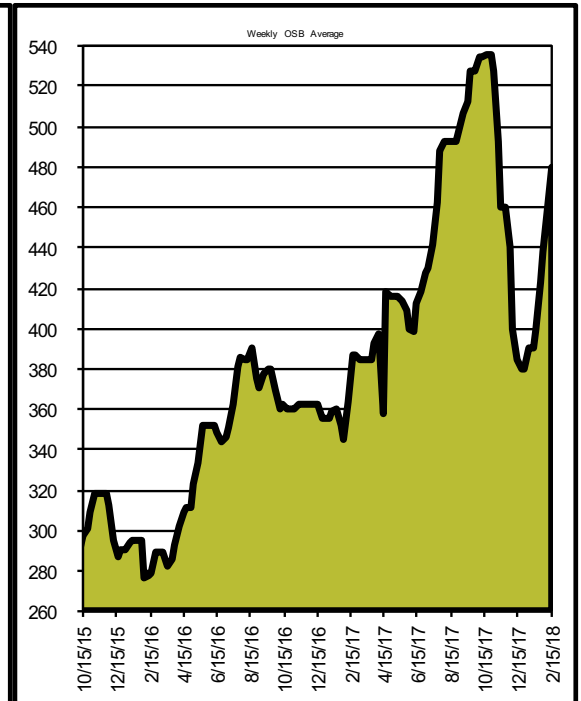

Distributors and dealers continue to wait on the arrival of delayed rail shipments, driving street level pricing higher yet. Prompt shipping loads remain difficult and expensive to come by. There are a lot of bloody noses out there from the heights of the prices we are living with today. Hoping the oxygen masks drop from the ceiling soon. Until more supply shows up – or this robust demand subsists – we are all going to continue paying up for wood.
