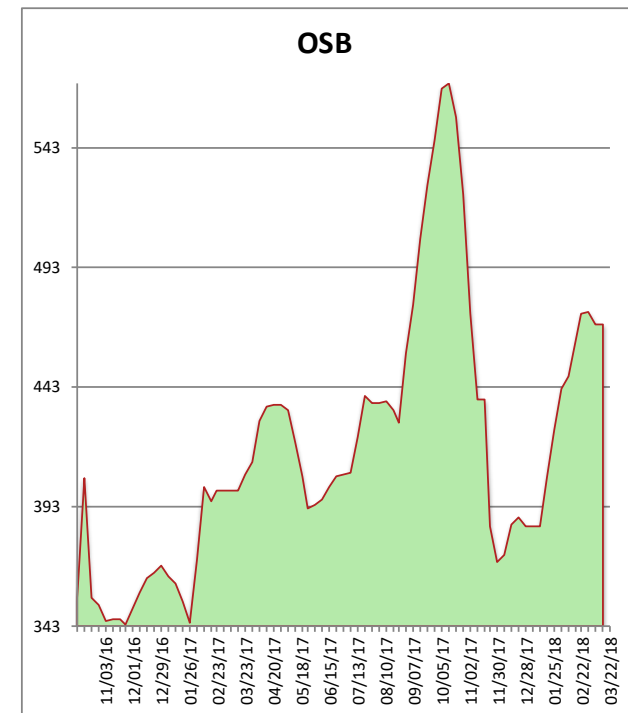
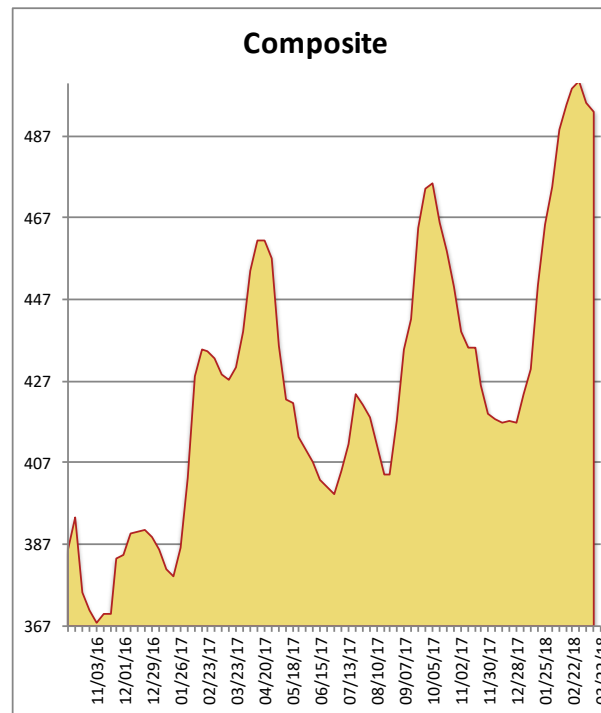

Lumber and panels are on different tracks in recent weeks. DF dimension - and especially green DF - are in Tom Petty mode (Free Fallin') while panels - especially OSB - manage to hold firm at record high prices once again. News of upcoming OSB curtailments are disconcerting to buyers who have been waiting all year for a correction - so OSB is in a different kind of Tom Petty mode (Don't Do Me Like That). SYP is the least vulnerable lumber item for now, but in other species - including SPF - it's double-digit drops this week.
