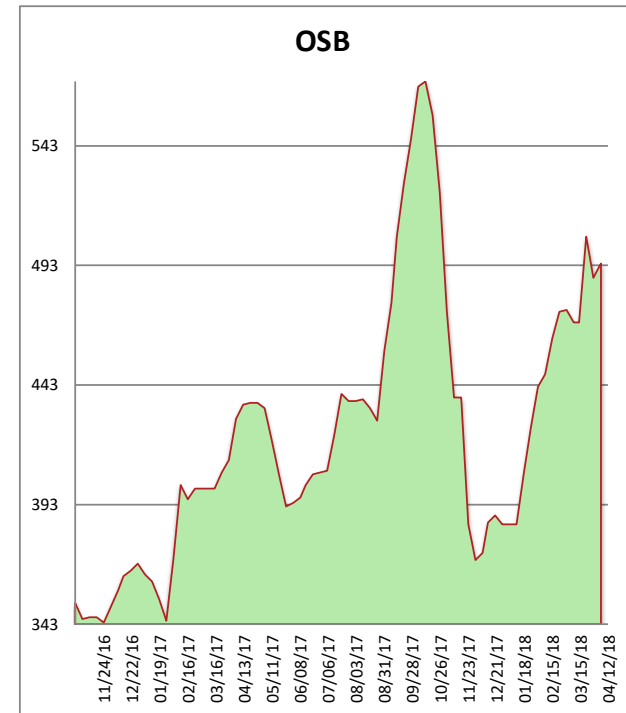
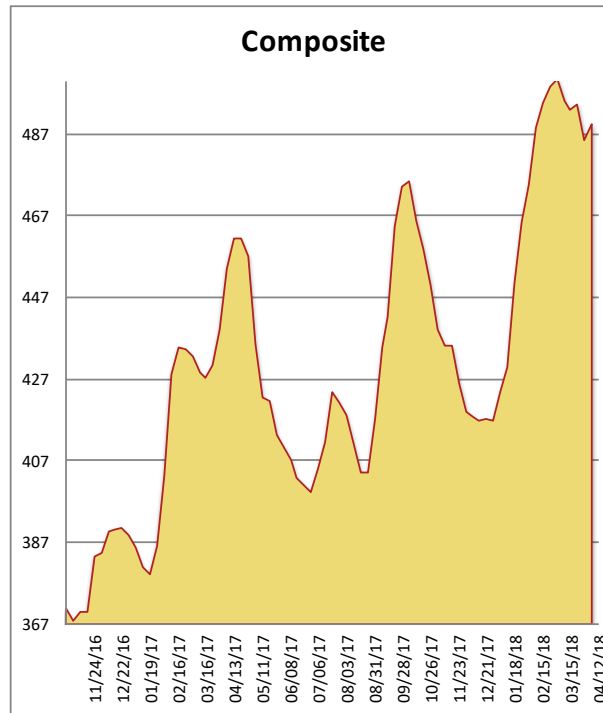

Lumber was a mixed bag this week. SYP found a trading level and firmed up in price. Activity in Texas was strong. Spruce dimension stayed solid with prices ticking up on the heels of heavier activity the week prior. Green DF stayed relatively flat while dry DF softened in price, and Hem Fir prices climbed. Plywood saw lackluster activity, and OSB was generally quiet early, though news that two producers would take production downtime perked up some ears in those regions. In the NE, hickory prices climbed as Red Sox/Yankee brawls made for some broken bats at Fenway Park.
