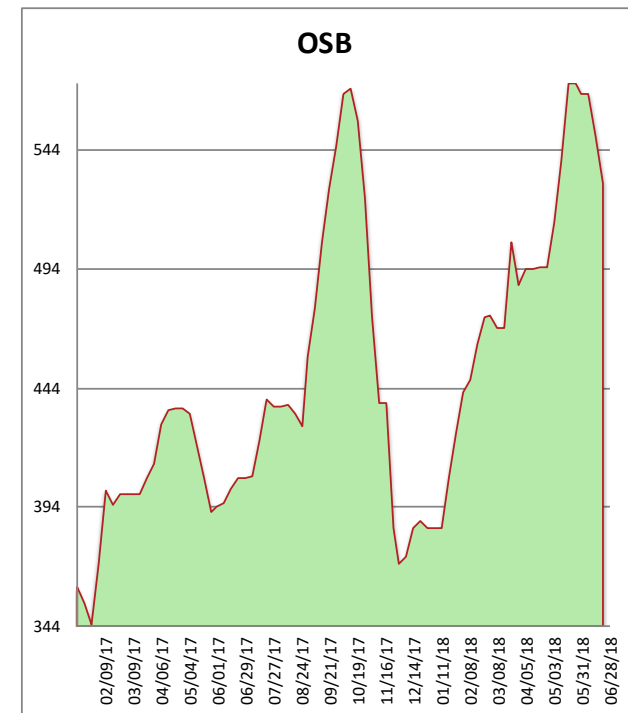
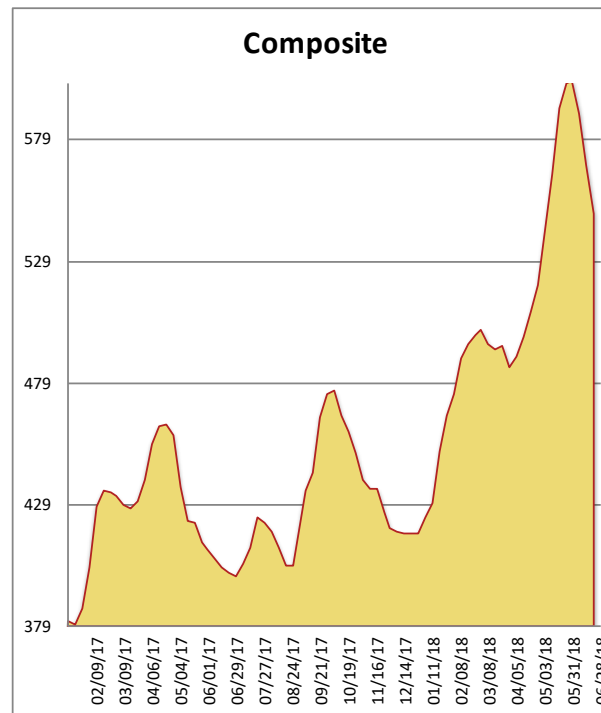

Green and dry 2x4x9 ft DF studs were the exception. Some buyers stepped in to cover jobs at lower prices, but the overall market still seems to be bearish with the wholesalers and distributors looking for a solid trading level as prices slide. The supply side continues to build with improved rail flow out of Canada and a steady flow of logs into mill decks. Trucking continues to be under supplied and expensive. The upcoming midweek July 4th break will be disruptive to both buyers and sellers. While lumber and panels lose double digits, lets hope none of us do...
