



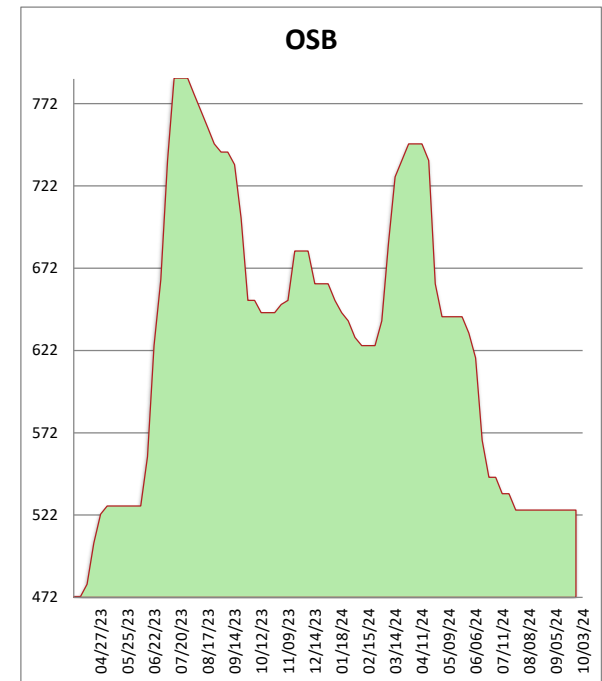
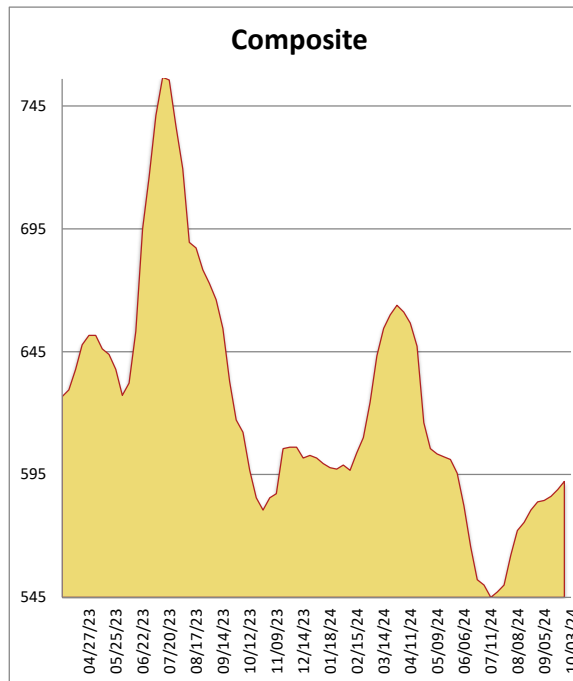

This week's market mirrored last week's market closely, with SYP perking up early in the week and GDF peeling off yet again. Hurricane Helena has created issues on the production side for SYP mills, and some traders bought extra inventory in light of it. More than likely is the scenario that demand will also be weakened due to the hurricane. Structural panel markets floundered along once again this week, with minimal changes to market pricing - but OSB is starting to show some cracks in the western markets. The dock workers strike, if allowed to go on for an extended time, will impact availability of imported lumber and panels.
